INTERSOLAR EUROPE 2026 — ESPE TO EXHIBIT MADE-IN-ITALY POWER STATIONS FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURES

ESPE Power Stations are electrical substations designed, assembled and tested at the company's Grantorto facilities, now available on the international market

Grantorto (Padua), 18 June 2026 - The EPC contractor ESPE S.p.A. ("ESPE" or the "Company"), parent company of the **ESPE Group**, operates in the renewable energy sector supplying photovoltaic systems and is also the owner of "ESPE" brand technology used in the manufacture of small-medium wind turbines and biomass cogenerators. ESPE will be present at **Intersolar Europe 2026**, scheduled to take place from **23 to 25 June 2026** at the **Messe München** exhibition centre in Munich, an event that is part of the **Smarter E Europe** platform. The company will be welcoming visitors and trade professionals in **Hall A3, at stand 460**.

Intersolar Europe is the leading European trade show dedicated to renewables, energy storage systems and energy infrastructures of the future; the 2026 edition is expected to attract around **1,300 exhibitors** and more than **1,500 suppliers** of solar energy related products and services, using around **101,000 m²** of exhibition space.

This year, the company will make a concerted effort to interest the international market in **ESPE Power Stations**, a range of electrical substations launched in 2025, designed, assembled and tested at the company's facilities in Grantorto, near Padua. The aim is to enhance the profile of the ESPE Group as a technology partner and a provider of integrated solutions for the conversion and distribution of energy, serving utility-scale photovoltaic and BESS storage systems, and next-generation energy infrastructures.

The centrepiece among the items on display will be the new **ESPE Double Power Shelter**, evolving the platform developed by the company for higher-power systems and making full use of **plug & play** features: a packaged Power Station, fully pre-assembled and factory-tested, ready for transportation, placement on site and connection to the grid, so that installation times, operational complexity and on-site activities are much reduced.

Enrico Meneghetti, Chairman and CEO of **ESPE**, made this comment: *"Intersolar Europe 2026 gives us an important opportunity to raise awareness of ESPE's technological and manufacturing expertise on the international market. Exhibiting the range of ESPE Power Stations, we can showcase solutions that fully embody our industrial approach: in-house design, manufacturing capacity, technological integration and close attention to product quality. The demand in the renewables market is for infrastructures that must be more and more reliable, modular and quick to install, which means pre-assembled and factory-tested substations have significant practical advantages for photovoltaic projects, BESS systems and complex energy infrastructures"*.

ESPE S.p.A.

The company ESPE S.p.A. ("ESPE" or the "Company"), based in Grantorto (Padua), has been active in the energy sector since 1974 and gained a reputation as a developer of innovative solutions for the production of energy from renewable sources. Drawing on over 50 years of experience, ESPE builds industrial electrical installations and advanced automation systems and is a leading EPC contractor for ground-mounted photovoltaic arrays and solar farms, as well as a System Integrator for complex infrastructure solutions. Over time, the company has expanded its expertise in renewable energy, establishing itself in the photovoltaic, small-medium wind turbine and biomass cogeneration sectors, thanks not least to its ESPE brand proprietary technologies. In 2024, ESPE consolidated its corporate structure through strategic moves including the acquisition of Permotech S.r.l., a company specializing in the development of large scale PV systems, and the purchase of a stake in Rigoni Lab S.r.l., an applied engineering concern, which also had the effect of adding strength and depth to its design skills and operational efficiency. With a view to optimizing the services provided with its offering, and streamlining the organizational structure, O&M operations were transferred to Reflow S.r.l., a subsidiary owned 57% by ESPE. In January 2025, ESPE acquired a 30% stake in Soland S.r.l., a Piedmont-based company operating in the design and construction of photovoltaic and energy efficiency systems, then in July —seeking to strengthen the Energy Security supply chain — a controlling interest of 51% in Secur Impianti S.r.l., specialist supplier of security and video surveillance systems for infrastructures. Serving a clientèle that includes large industrial groups, SMEs and Italian and international investors, ESPE is well-known as a provider of tailor-made, technologically advanced solutions and as a campaigner for sustainable growth and innovation, underscoring its place among the leading players in the renewable energy sector.

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
